ART WEEK CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

DRAWING | Advance your skills in both drawing and color use while working from objects, photographs, and clothed models. Starting with pencils and charcoal, learn how to observe and render the real world. You will then progress to using chalk pastels as a means for furthering not only your observational skills but your creative ideas. *There is a supply list for this class.* Tuition: \$175

FLAMEWORKING | Learn the fundamentals of flameworking: melting and manipulating glass over a benchtop torch. Explore the artistic possibilities of this warm glass techniques used for creating everything from beads to sculptures. Learn about tools, safety, equipment, and techniques of this versatile and popular art form. Tuition: \$225

GLASSBLOWING | Discover the universal appeal of shaping molten glass. Individualized instruction will help you learn the basics of glassblowing: gathering glass from the furnace and blowing and shaping bubbles. Make your own glass cup or sculptural paperweight while learning how to shape the glass with tools. *Students must be at least 15 years old.* Tuition: \$325

KILN-FORMED GLASS | Explore multiple methods of shaping glass in a kiln. Learn the fundamentals of one of the most common forms of kiln-glass. Through exercises in glass cutting, demonstrations of layout, and discussions about color combinations, you will gain the foundation to design and create in glass. Make handkerchief bowls, plates, 3D reliefs, and flat tiles. Tuition: \$225

PAINTING | Building on the foundations of drawing you will explore basic painting concepts. Learn a variety of techniques focusing on the versatility of acrylic paint. You will mix colors, experiment with paint application, and focus on composition while studying from still-lives and landscapes. *There is a supply list for this class.* Tuition: \$160

PRINTMAKING | Experiment with a variety of printmaking techniques and discover your passion for this art form. You will create a multiple works on paper using block printing, monotype, and stenciling techniques. By the end of the week you will be confident using the presses and inks and be able to create beautiful prints. Tuition: \$190

STOP MOTION ANIMATION CLASS | Come learn how to make a physically-manipulated object appear to move on its own using stop motion (also known as stop-action or frame by frame). You will learn the basic steps in the process such as moving objects in small increments between individually photographed frames and creating the illusion of movement. Learn about animation, storyboarding, and building props and sets with everyday materials. You will produce a collaborative animated short film. *This is a full day class, 9:00am to 4:00pm, offered February 20 – 24 and August 27 – 31 only.* Tuition: \$350

WELDING AND METAL SCULPTURE | Through innovative and hands-on projects, get your first taste of welding and metal fabrication. You will develop a new skill-set while learning the fundamentals of sculpture and design in three dimensions. By the end of the class, you will take home a sculpture or piece of furniture that you have created from design to patina finish. Tuition: \$220
