



TERESA JANE TEEN GLASS SCHOLARSHIP 2018-2019

Scholarship Background:

The Theresa Jane Teen Glass Scholarship provides glass instruction, professional mentorship, and portfolio-development support to a self-identifying female high-school student entering her sophomore or junior year at the beginning of the 2018-19 school year. The scholarship is designed to help her create a body of work for a college-application portfolio, and to support her growth as a professional glass artist. This scholarship is generously underwritten by the Theresa Jane Fund.

Award Description:

The award year runs from September 1, 2018, to August 31, 2019. During the award year the Theresa Jane Teen Glass Scholarship will provide:

- \$3,000 credit at Pratt Fine Arts Center to apply towards class/workshop registrations and related supply fees (Teen, Adult, and Master Classes at Pratt Fine Arts Center are eligible)
- \$500 reimbursement for professional portfolio photography services
- \$700 materials stipend paid directly to the artist
- 6 meetings with a mentor throughout the award year (required)

Eligibility:

Open to high-school students entering their sophomore or junior year in fall of 2018 who:

- self-identify as female;
- currently live in Washington State;
- have had at least one year of glass instruction.

Children of board and advisory-board members, instructors, and staff of Pratt Fine Arts Center are not eligible.

Application Evaluation:

Applications will be reviewed by a panel of Pratt staff, professional artists, and industry experts. The scholarship will be awarded to the applicant who demonstrates exceptional promise.

Application Requirements:

All applications should clearly articulate the anticipated educational impact of the award and must include:

- A completed scholarship application form
- A typewritten essay that addresses the following questions:
 - What are your goals if you were to receive the Theresa Jane Teen Glass Scholarship?
 - skills or techniques to explore or develop
 - classes/workshops you plan to take
 - What is your experience to date with glass? Where and with whom did you study?
 - Which glass artists inspire you and why?
 - How would the Theresa Jane Teen Glass Scholarship support your future plans in the arts?
- Three (3) images of current work – JPEGs files size no larger than 2MB each. Label your JPEGs with your last name and title (if applicable). Images of glass work preferred.
- Letter of recommendation from a current or past instructor, no more than one page in length.

DEADLINE: APPLICATIONS ARE DUE JUNE 5, 2018. A winner will be announced in July 2018.
