

Call for Art at the Pratt Gallery at Tashiro Kaplan Studios, Seattle, Washington

The Pratt Gallery at Tashiro Kaplan Studios is an 800sf exhibition space located in the Pioneer Square neighborhood in Seattle.

Pratt is seeking submissions from artists who would like use the space for the month of October 2012. Artists in all media are invited to apply.

Application deadline is April 1, 2012.

Application requirements:

- Exhibition proposal: a written outline of the theme and scope of the show.
- Up to 10 jpegs of work on a cd. Please note that Pratt may use the images provided in future marketing materials.
- Work sample description sheet: title, year made, materials used, photo credit
- Resume
- Artist Statement
- A \$50 non-refundable application fee. (\$25 non-refundable application fee for current Pratt members).

Image preparation guidelines:

Each image must be 72 ppi/dpi/resolution.

Each image file must be a "jpeg".

The image size should not exceed 900 pixels in height or 1200 pixels in width. Each file should not exceed 5MB.

Label your JPEG files "01 to 10" followed by your last name. For example, Joe Smith's image files would be: 01Smith.jpg, 02Smith.jpg, etc.

Number the image file names in the order you would like them viewed. Make sure these numbers correspond to your Work Sample Description Sheet.

Put only the images you are submitting for the application on the CD.

Write your name, address, and phone number on your CD and CD case.

Information

Pratt will provide:

- Use of the gallery for the month of October 2012.
- Assistance in the installation of the show. Pratt has a limited number of pedestals available for use and plexiglass vitrines
- Pratt staff to sit on public hours. Other arrangements can be made with prior approval.
- Pratt will provide a loan agreement for the piece(s) of work/object(s) displayed and will insure items whilst they are on display. Artists receive a 60% commission on all sales and Pratt will handle all sales.

Exhibition dates:

- The exhibition will open on 1st Thursday October 4, 5-8pm.
- The gallery keeps public hours 12-5pm on Thursday-Saturday

Other

- Pratt regrets that we are not able to offer any financial support towards artist fees, transport, travel or accommodation.
- Artist will be responsible for transport to and from Pratt and will need to be able to pay for any associated postage/transport costs
- Pratt cannot cover costs associated with supporting talks or events.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- Pratt cannot be responsible for the return of materials
