This part-time position works with the Large Metals/Sculpture Studios Manager. **The primary responsibility is monitoring the Forge and Fabrication Studios during Student Friday Sessions for students enrolled in weekly forge/fabrication classes.** Student Friday Sessions are monitored open studio times for students to practice the skills they learned in their classes and time outside of class to work on assigned projects. The chief role of this position is to support the student experience through encouragement, reinforcement of instructor lead learnings, and assisting students with mastering basic skills. The successful applicant will be able to clearly communicate technical information to students while maintaining a safe studio environment, and is committed to fostering a universally welcoming and respectful environment.
