Mary & Gary Molyneaux Scholarship for Womxn

Through the generous support of Mary and Gary Molyneaux, Pratt is pleased to offer a new scholarship supporting the continued advancement of womxn over 50 years of age. This scholarship is designed to support an artist to further their skillset and/or explore new disciplines.

Eligibility: The award is open to practicing artists 50 years of age or over who identify as female. Board, the advisory board, and staff members of Pratt Fine Arts Center, as well as Pratt instructors, are not eligible to apply.

Application Evaluation: The Mary & Gary Molyneaux Scholarship for Womxn will be awarded to the applicant for whom the award would be most transformational, as indicated by the quality of past work and the intended use of scholarship funds. Applications will be evaluated by a jury comprised of artists and arts professionals with expertise in the field of visual art.

Scholarship Award: The award, a \$1,250 scholarship and Master level Pratt membership, may be applied exclusively towards class/workshop registrations and studio access fees in Pratt Fine Arts Center's studios, and must be used between September 1, 2020 and August 31, 2021.*

Eligibility: The award is open to individuals over 50 years of age who identify as female.

These are artists who are pursuing higher education and possess a personal or professional interest in making art a lifelong passion.

Board, advisory board, and staff members of Pratt Fine Arts Center, as well as Pratt instructors, are not eligible to apply.

Application Requirements

- 1. Statement of intent, no longer than one page, explaining:
 - **a.** how this award will enhance your artistic development and goals
 - **b.** what you intend to explore or accomplish with this scholarship
 - c. why you need scholarship funding to complete these goals
- 2. Three (3) to six (6) JPEG images of current work JPEGS should be formatted to 7 inches on the longest side, with minimum resolution of 180dpi, and file size no larger than 2MB each. Label your JPEGS with you last name, title of piece, and numbered order for viewing.**
- 3. Numbered image list that includes the following information for each piece:
 - **a.** title
 - **b.** dimensions
 - **c.** medium
 - d. year of completion
- 4. Completed online application form

DEADLINE: APPLICATIONS ARE DUE JUNE 21, 2020.

A winner will be announced in late July, and award year begins September 1, 2020.
