



2024-25 Pratt/Seattle Print Arts Partners Grant

In partnership with Seattle Print Arts (SPA), and to nurture the development of our shared artist community, Pratt is pleased to offer an enhanced funding grant in printmaking (formerly known as the Seattle Print Arts Scholarship). This grant is specifically for Puget Sound printmakers who are members of Seattle Print Arts.

Grant Award:

The Pratt/SPA Partners Grant, a \$1,000 award, is to be applied towards printmaking classes and workshops, and supply fees at Pratt Fine Arts Center. A \$700 stipend will be distributed directly to the recipient for purchasing materials and supplies. In addition to the financial award, the recipient will also receive:

- One-year SPA membership renewal
- One-year Master Level membership at Pratt Fine Arts Center
- Access to Pratt's Printmaking Studio for the duration of the award year, this runs September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025. * (Valued at \$2,340; 12 months x \$195/month)

Eligibility:

The Pratt/SPA Partners Grant is open to printmakers of all levels, aged 18 years and older, who are active members of SPA and who wish to refine their skills or pursue new or experimental directions in their discipline. Previous involvement or prerequisite classes at Pratt are not required. Pratt staff, board members, and instructors not eligible.

Application Evaluation:

The Pratt/SPA Partners Grant will be awarded to the applicant who best demonstrates artistic merit and articulates his/her creative intent and anticipated educational impact of the prize. Applications will be reviewed by a committee of Pratt staff, SPA board members, and other arts professionals with printmaking expertise.





Application Requirements (Due July 14, 2024):

- **Statement of Intent** (500 words):
 - o Projects you intend to explore / execute
 - Skills / techniques you want to develop
 - o Classes / workshops you want to take
 - o How the scholarship relates to your past work and future goals
 - Why you need this grant to accomplish your goals
- Four to Six Artwork Images (JPEGs):
 - o Formatted to 7" longest side, 180dpi, max 2MB each
 - o Labeled with your last name, title, and number
- Numbered Image List (PDF)
 - o Title, dimensions, medium, year created, photo credit (if applicable)
- Resume or CV (PDF)
- Online Application Form

Important Dates:

- Application Deadline: July 14, 2024
- Winner Announcement: mid-August 2024
- Award Year Begins: September 1, 2024

Please note:

- * Successful completion of a studio orientation and access test are required to use Pratt's studios independently.
- This is a competitive scholarship. Be sure to submit a strong application that showcases your talent and dedication to your art.
- Pratt and/or SPA may use your submitted images in marketing materials to promote the scholarship.
